



ASSESSMENT CENTER PROCTORING REQUESTS

The Davis Technical College (Davis Tech) can proctor computer or paper/pencil tests during our regular testing hours (detailed below). Listed below are the student and school requirements for proctored tests.

Student

- Provide a tentative testing date and time (per our testing hours) listed below.
- Provide this document to your school. Ask them to submit a test proctor approval form (if your school requires a Proctor to complete one.)
- **On the day of the test:**
 - ✓ Pay the \$25.00 Proctoring Fee
 - ✓ Bring Government issued valid Photo ID
 - ✓ Check in at the Student Services desk (see attached campus map), pay the proctoring fee then present the receipt to the Assessment Center (located in the same area).

Student's School/Instructor

Send all testing information to the Davis Tech Proctor **at least 48 working hours** in advance of the test date to include:

- Test Name and duration
- Test Type: Computer, Paper/Pencil, timed/untimed, open book etc.
- Computer requirements (if online): Weblink, Access/Proctor codes, computer specifications (such as lockdown browser etc.)
- Allowable Materials: For example: Scratch paper, calculator, books, reference notes etc.
- Any information that needs to be returned to the school after the test
- Any additional proctoring requirements
- Contact name and number in case of any questions or technical difficulties
