4 Steps to creating a personalized message

"Hello, my name is . I am a student at Davis Technical College studying ."

2. Tell them who you know

" is an instructor/colleague of mine. They suggested I speak with you because I'm interested in ."

3. The "What & Why"

Tell them what it is you are interested in and why you are interested in connecting with them.

4. It's a date

Be proactive and respectful in requesting a date and time to meet them.

SOCIAL MEDIA NETWORKING

Facebook, Intagram, and LinkedIn have quickly created a presence in the professional world. Many employers use social media as a part of their recruiting strategy to connect with potential hires.

- 1. Join professional associations on Facebook and LinkedIn.
- 2. Research companies- if they are a company you are interested in working for, like their page.
- 3. Update your profile with posts related to your job search.
- 4. Choose a professional head shot photo on LinkedIn and build your professional profile.
- 5. What's your name? Michael or Mike Katherine or Kate. Decide on one and be consistent.
- **6. Establish connections** with a personalized message.
- 7. Ask for recommendations from past supervisors and instructors on LinkedIn.
